Summary

The Sunflower Slam Volleyball Tournament. Matches will be played at the Okun Fieldhouse on Saturday, March 29th. The Okun Fieldhouse is run by Johnson County Parks and Recreation. There will be two pools of five teams. This is a Silver tournament which means that it is open to Silver and Bronze teams only. The facility does not allow outside food or drink. However, you can eat in the parking lot. Warm-up begins at 7:45a.m. Coaches meeting will be at 7:30 a.m. The first round of pool play begins at 8:00 a.m.

Warm-ups for first rounds of play: 2 minutes of ball handling on each side of the net by both teams. Each team - full court 4 minutes. After first rounds of play- warm-ups will be 1 minute ball handling/3 minute court time per team.

Tournament Play

Tournament play will be divided into Pool Play (morning) and Bracket Play (afternoon). Pool play will consist of two games to 25 points, win by two with no cap, rally scoring, starting with 4-4 on the scoreboard. Top 4 from each pool advance to Tournament (bracket) play. The teams will be ranked for Bracket play accordingly to the following:

1. Win-loss record.
2. Head to head competition.
3. Point differential between tied teams.
4. Point differential in all games.
5. If a tie still exists then a 15 point tie breaker game will be played to determine team to advance to tournament play.

Bracket Play

Bracket games are single-elimination, 2 out of 3 games. The first 2 games will be 4 to 25 points, rally scoring, win by two points with no cap. If the third game is necessary it will be 15-point rally beginning at zero. No cap. Medals will be presented to the first place team in each age division. During Playoffs the losing team is required to officiate the following match.
